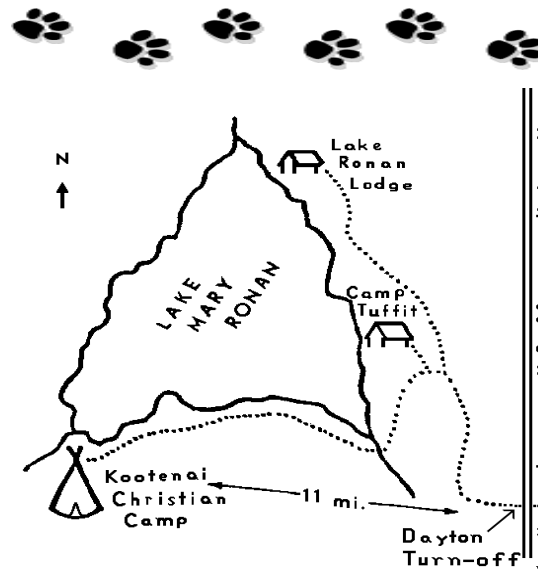

Leave all equipment in its proper place.

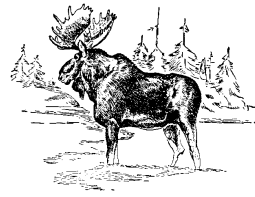
